ETHIOPIA

A local team from a previous Fifty5five mission trip assisted us, as they prepare to take over future train-

ing programs there. We plan to make one final trip to Ethiopia to complete their training.

CAMBODIA

2017 Trips

Ethiopia – Fifty5five will return to Sendafa, Ethiopia, in June 2017 to again work with the Child Development Training and Research Center. In addition, we will provide a teacher training in Addis Ababa for Strong Hearts. We may add on an additional training program in Pretoria, South Africa. The approximate trip cost is \$3,000-\$4,000. Travelers may have the option to do just one country if necessary.

Dominican Republic -

Fifty5five may travel again to the Dominican Republic in 2017 to continue to work with the Good Samaritan Hospital, but this trip is still in the planning stages. The approximate trip cost is \$2,500.
